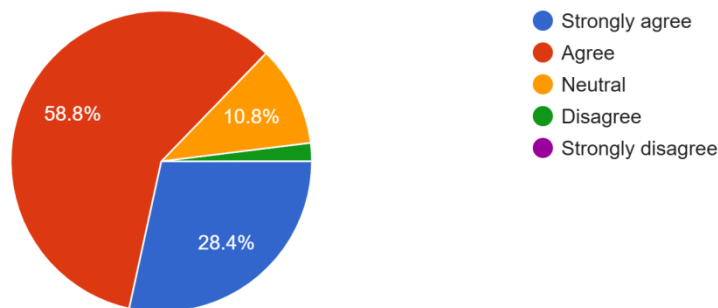

PART A -Feedback on Curriculum and Syllabus The prescribed syllabus is practical, adaptable and relevant to current requirements

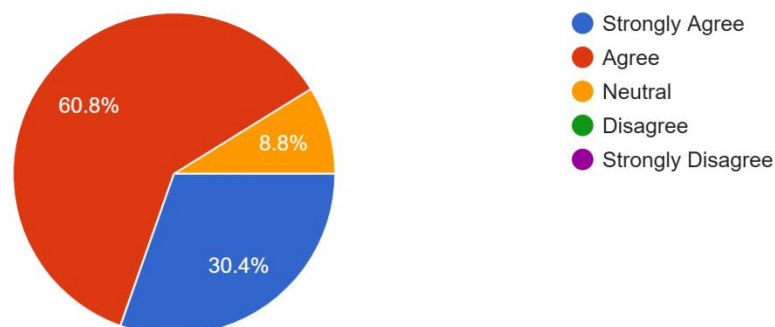
102 responses

There is a coherence/continuity among units/chapters/modules in the courses offered.

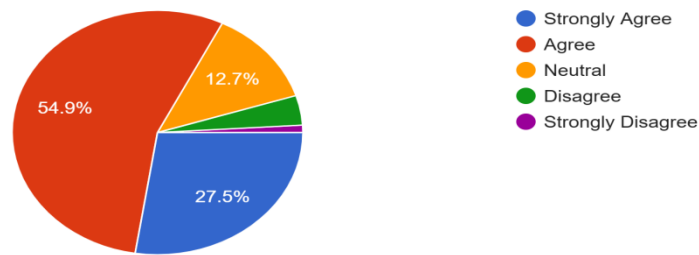

Curriculum provides for learning beyond classroom teaching like internship, student exchange and field visit

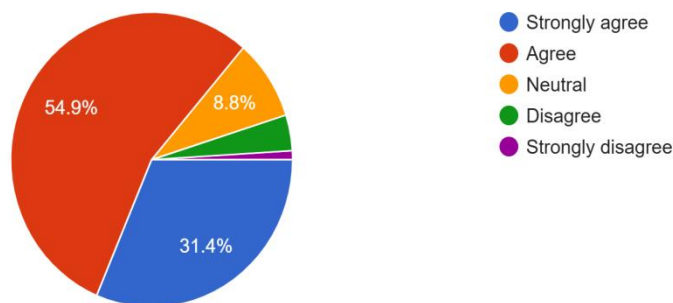

Curriculum is updated with skill based contents

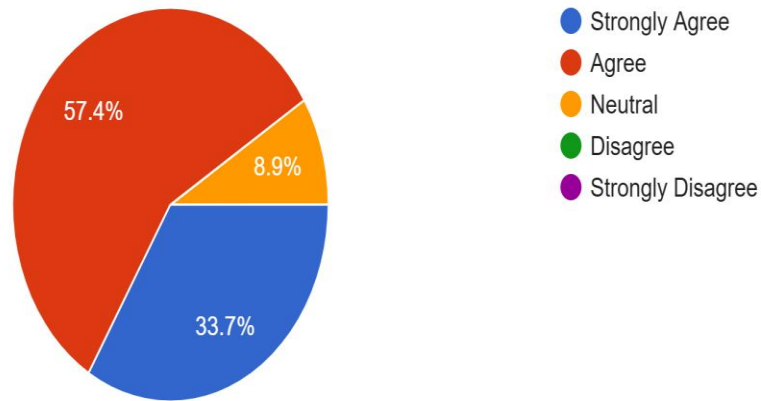

Curriculum provides interdisciplinary knowledge

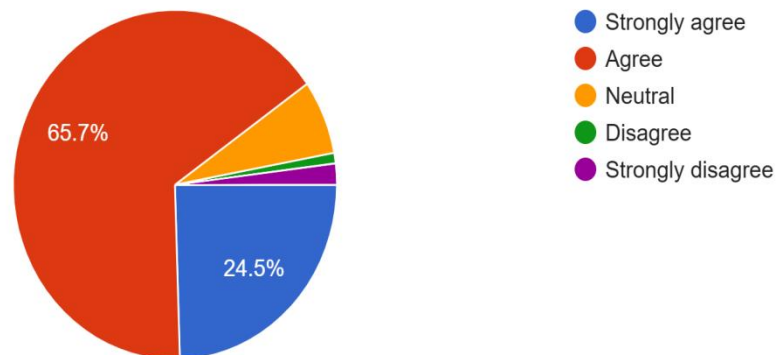

Curriculum helps to prepare for higher education and competitive exams

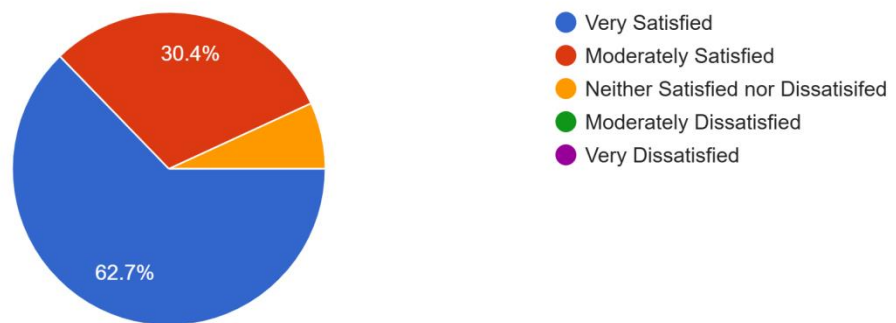

Rate the class room teaching by faculty members

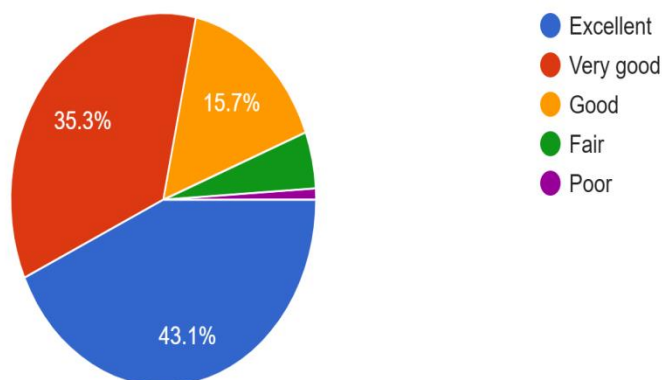

Rate the ICT usage by teachers in the classroom

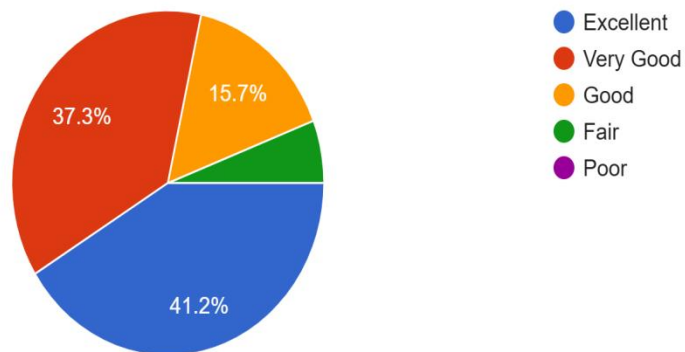

Rate the overall Syllabus

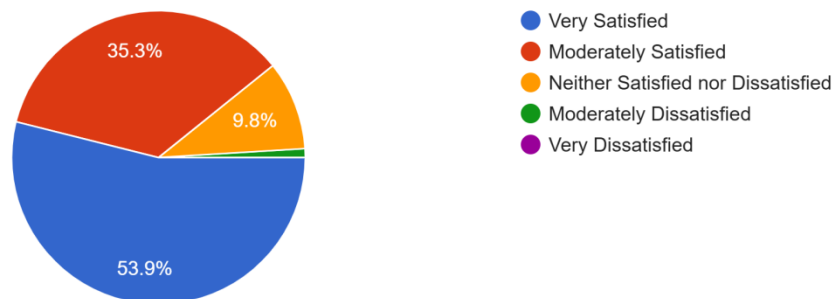

PART B - Feedback on infrastructure support and Ambience Rate the availability of ICT facilities in the College

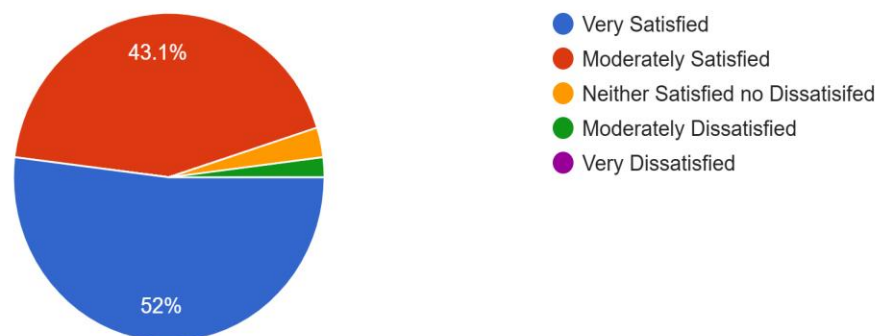

Rate the availability of books for the students with reference to courses offered

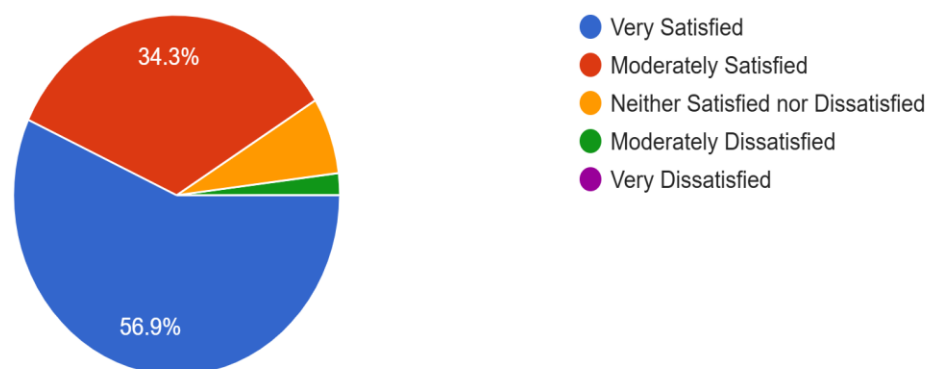

Rate the extent of library resources available to the students with reference to preparing for competitive examinations.

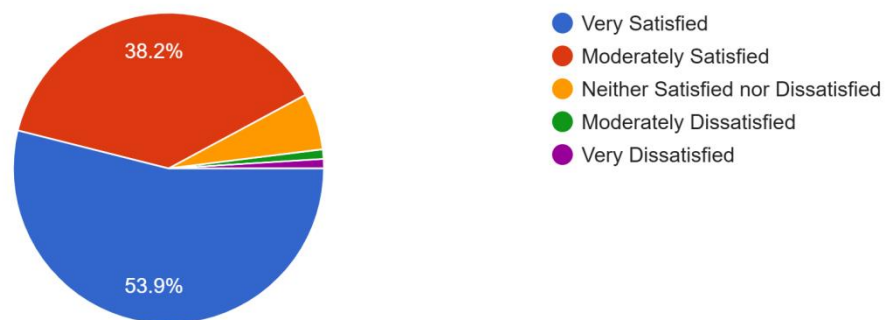

Rate the transparency with reference to conducting examinations(Internal/External)

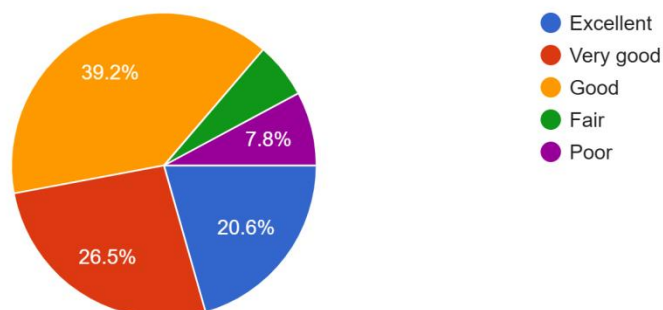

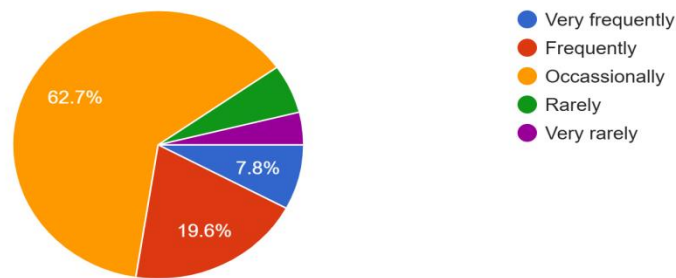
Availability of indoor and outdoor Sports facilities

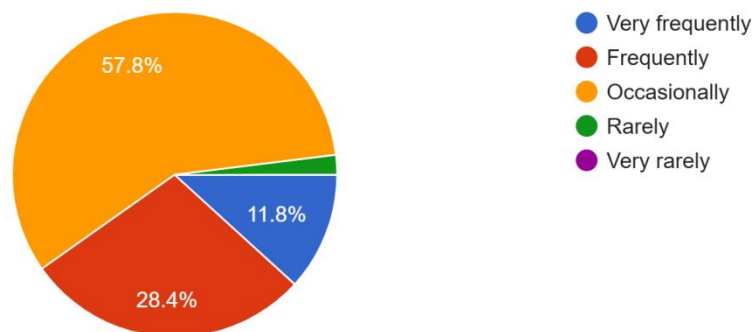

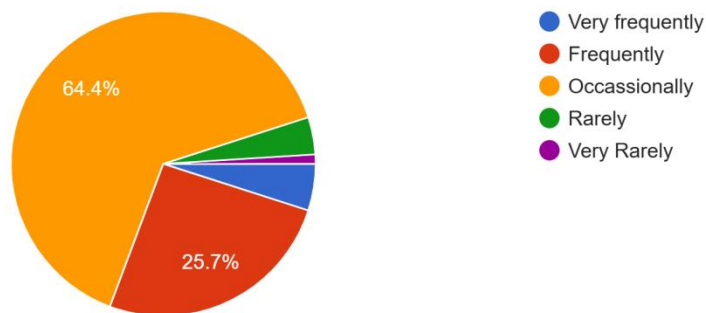
Regularity in conducting Cultural Activities

Regularity in conducting activities by Different Committees and Clubs.

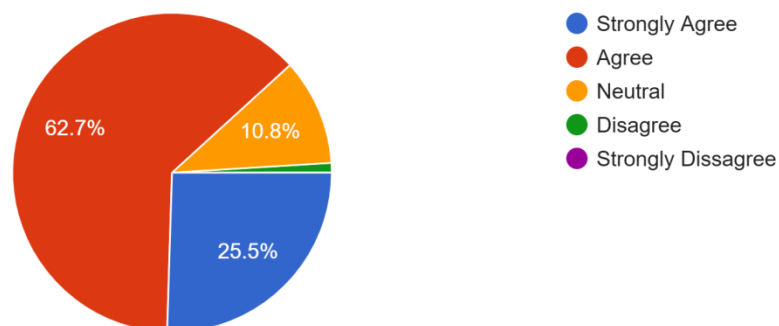

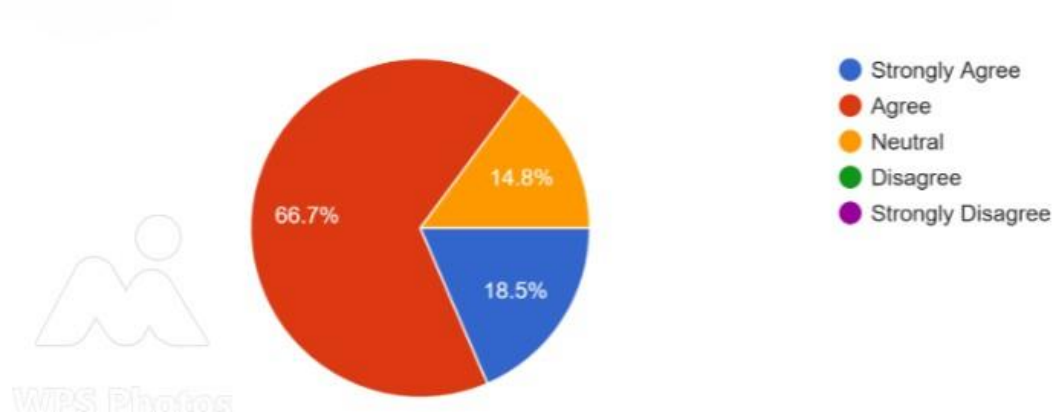

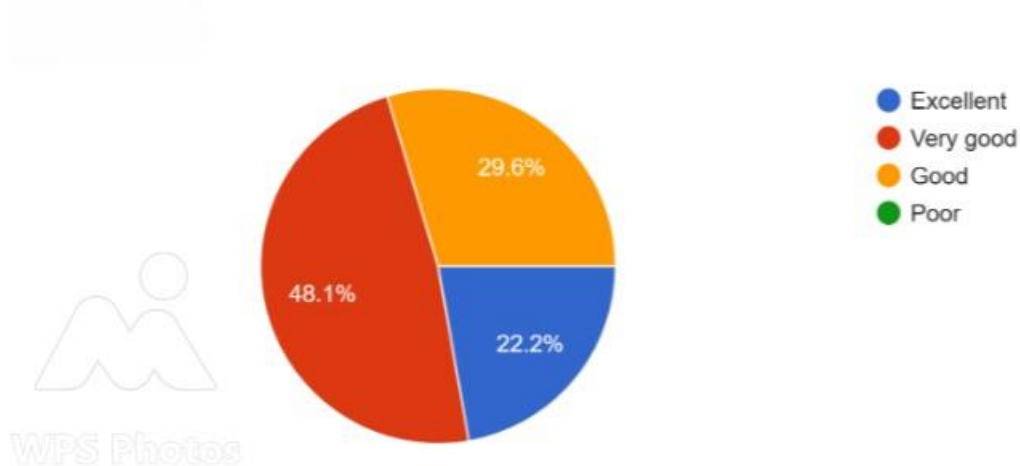

Platform is provided for regular interaction with current students



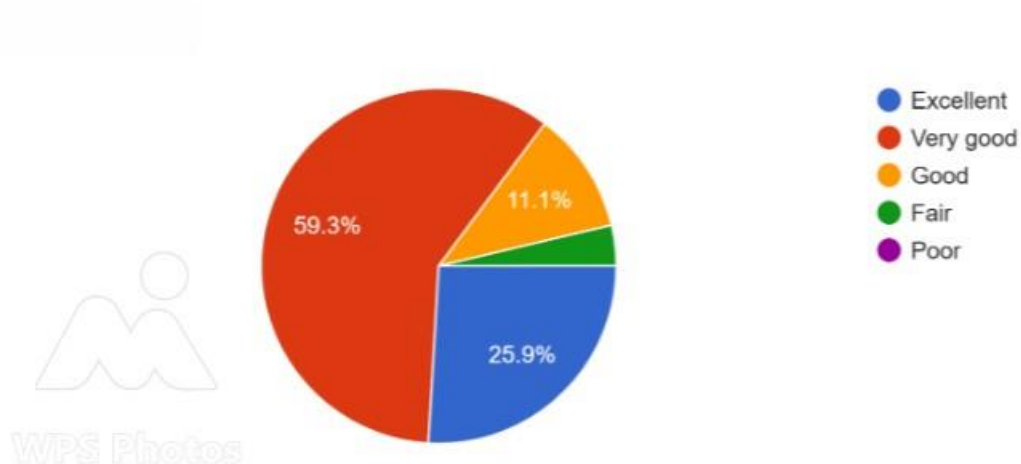

PART- B Alumni Association/Network of your college



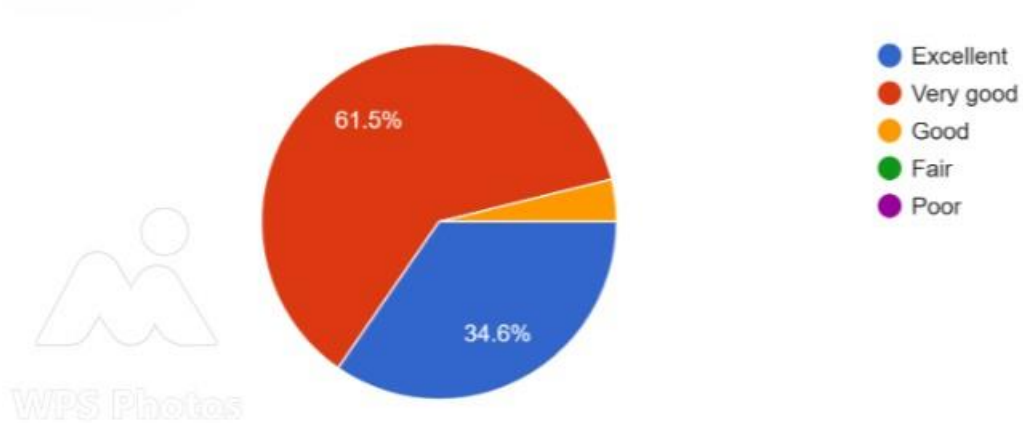

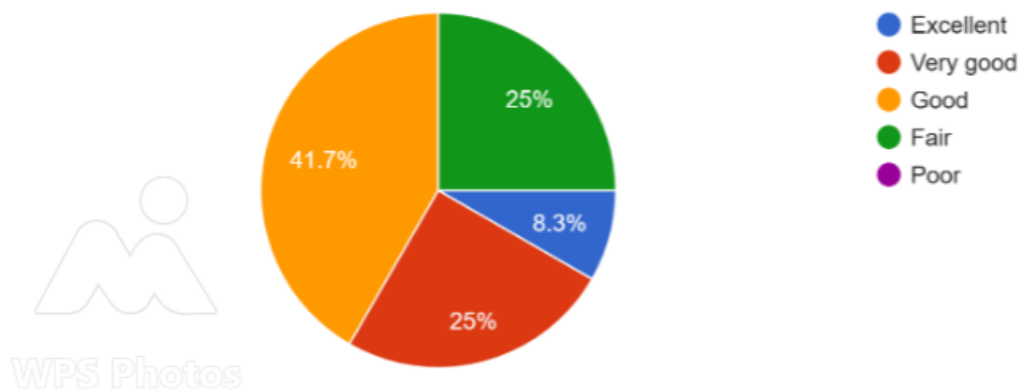

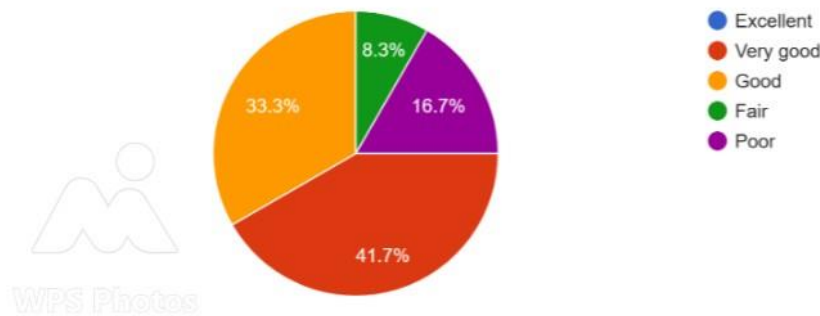

Power backup and internet facilities



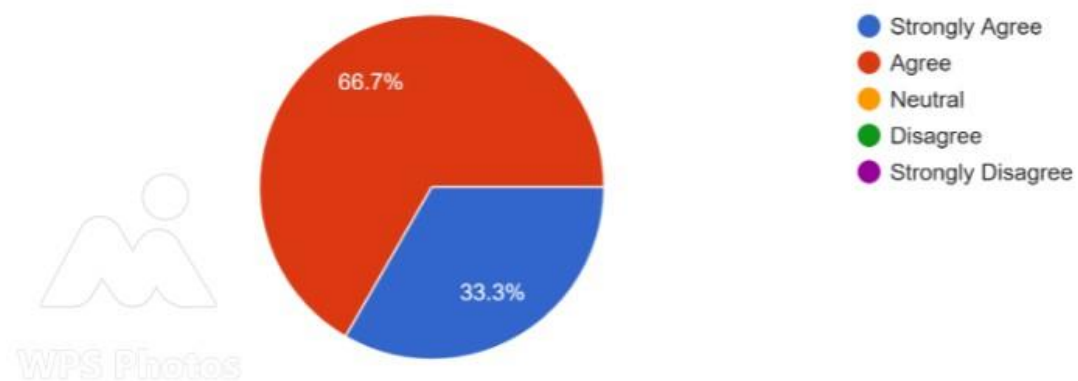

PART-B Feedback on infrastructure support and ambiance Rate the availability of ICT facilities in the college for teaching and learning



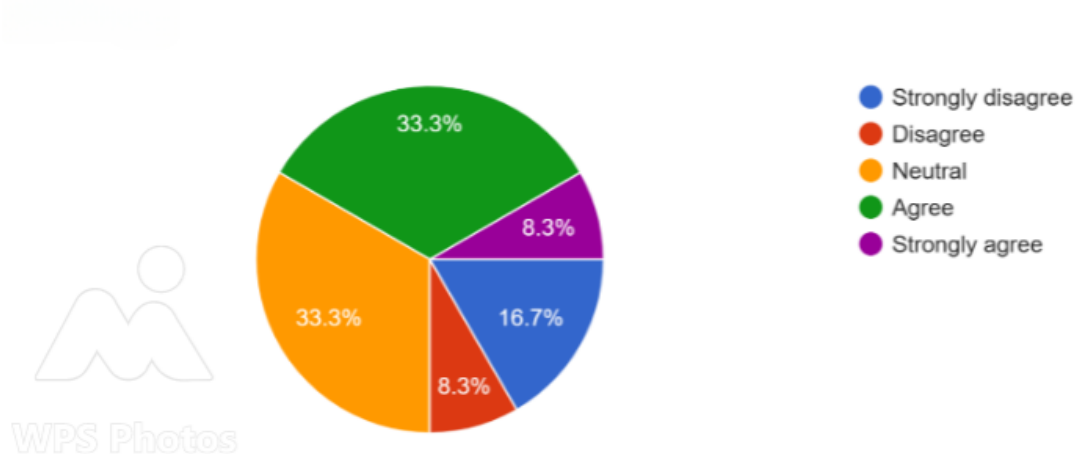

The time and credits for each course are well defined and distributed



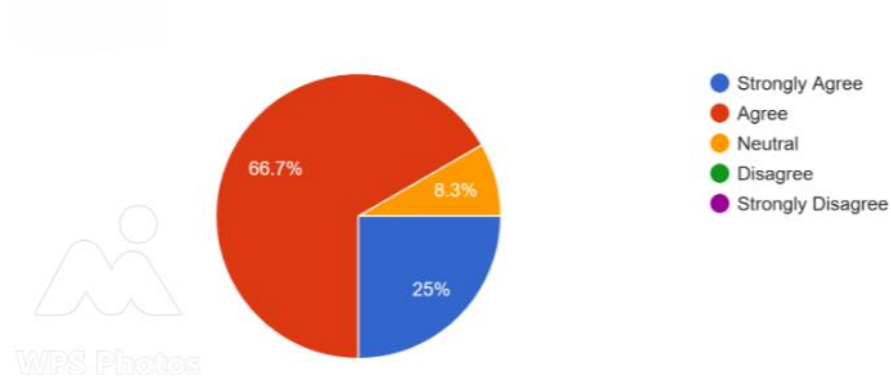

Curriculum is balanced with theoretical and practical knowledge



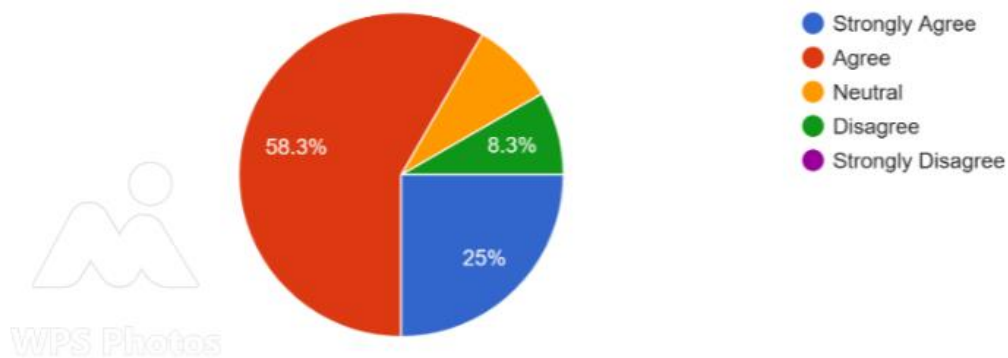

Institutions academic calendar of events is designed and implemented in adherence to university calendar of events



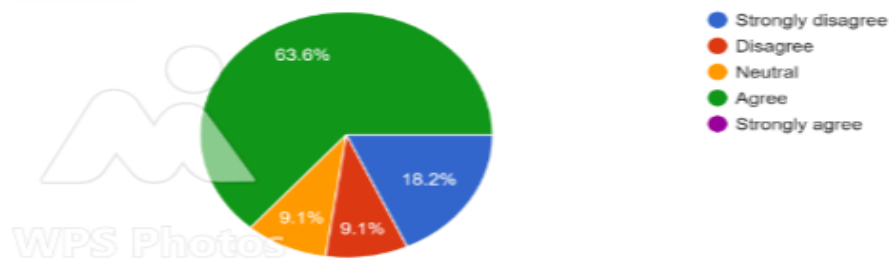

There is coherence among units/chapters/modules in the courses offered



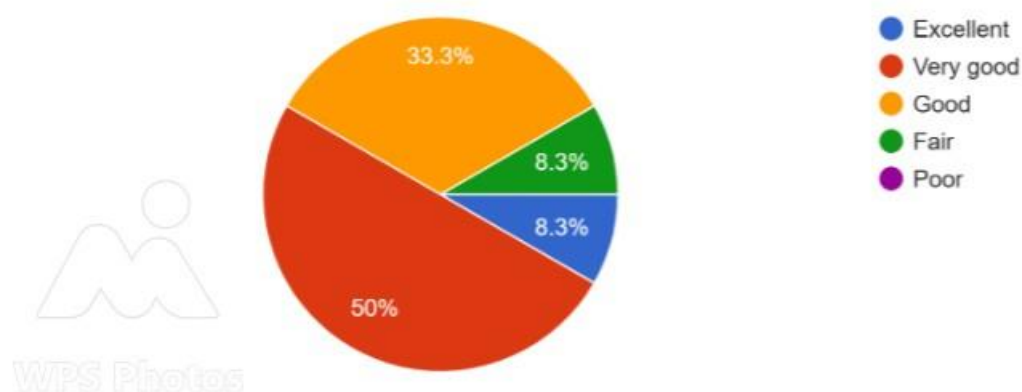
